"Transgenerational and Long-term Effects on the Mental Health of Internally Displaced People"

Only a few studies exist on the long-term and transgenerational effects of internal displacement on the mental health and wellbeing of internally displaced persons (IDPs) and their descendants. This webinar will draw on these data and analyses to shed light on the processes for transmission of the trauma versus resilience within IDP families and communities in countries affected by conflict and propose important theoretical insights, as well as assessing the implications for future research and policy.

The <u>Health and Internal Displacement Network</u> (HIDN) promotes research engagement and evidence-driven policy on IDP health.
